It is important to organize your garbage, recycling and organics. There are different types of bins for each – a grey bin for garbage, a blue bin for recycling, and a green bin for organics, also known as food waste. It is also important to help keep your community and the environment clean by not littering.

Beautification:	The process of making a particular place, area, or thing, more
	visually appealing.

- Community: The people, places, and things which make up the area in which we live and work.
- Eyesore: An area or building made visually unattractive by graffiti, litter, overgrown weeds, or accumulation of trash.

Litter Sorting:

Garbage – Q-tips, Toilet Paper Recycling – Paper Party Invitation, Milk Carton, Juice Box Organics/Food Waste – Banana Peel, Pomegranate, Avocado

Discussion Points:

Litter makes the environment look...

Answers will vary but may include unattractive, uncared for, or dirty. Encourage students to think about what it would be like if someone left trash in their backyard or outside their front door. Explain that it is important not to litter when you are out in public, and it is also important to sort your waste properly at home by using garbage, recycling and green bins.

An area I think should be beautified is...

Answers will vary but may include a park, parking lot or area around an apartment building, house, community centre or school where they have seen graffiti, overgrown plants, or lots of garbage.

I can keep my community clean by...

Answers will vary but may include picking up trash (around your house, apartment building or school), not littering and not vandalizing or doing graffiti. Encourage child to tell their parents or teachers when they see lots of garbage, overgrown plants, or graffiti.
